PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF ESTATES ACT, 1913.

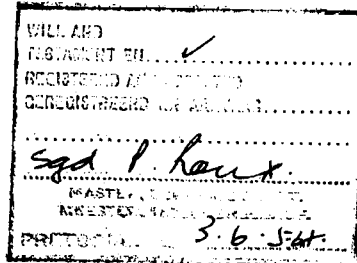

SECOND: We hereby nominate, constitute and appoint our daughter GWYN FLORENCE GURNOW, and any child or children that may hereafter be born of our marriage, together with the survivor of us, to be our sole and universal heirs, share and share alike, of all the property, estate and effects, inheritances and legacies, chattels, credits and things whatsoever and wheresoever the same may be of which we or either of us shall die possessed, whether movable or immovable and of what nature or kind soever, whether the same be in possession, reversion, remainder or expectancy, nothing excepted. Provided, however that we hereby declare it to be our express will and desire that the survivor of us shall be authorized

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THIRD: We nominate, constitute and appoint the survivor of us to be the Executor or Executrix of this our Will, and Administrator or Administratrix of all the property, estate and effects of the first dying of us, and of our joint estate, hereby giving and granting unto him or her all such power and authority as are required in law, and especially that of assumption.

LASTLY: We declare to reserve to ourselves at all times hereafter during our joint lives, the power, from time to time, and at all times hereafter, to make all such alterations in or additions to this Will as we shall think fit, either by a separate act or at the foot hereof, desiring that all such alterations or additions so made under our own signature, shall be held as valid and effectual as if they had been inserted herein.
