BE IT HEREBY MADE KNOWN :

THAT we, the undersigned, SIDNEY HENRY PENNY and MARY TRAHAIR JAMES (born Tregear), of Johannesburg, about to be married to each other in community of property, do hereby declare our intention to ~~and execute~~ this our Last Joint Mutual Will and Testament.

We hereby revoke, cancel and annul all previous Wills, Codicils and other Testamentary Acts heretofore made or passed by us, desiring that the same shall be of no force or effect whatsoever.

We hereby nominate, constitute and appoint the survivor of us to be the sole and universal heir or heiress of the whole of the Estate, goods and effects, movable or immovable and wheresoever the same may be situate, and which shall be left by the first dying of us and whether the same be in possession, reversion, remainder or expectancy, nothing excepted.
