I give and hereby bequeath unto my loving wife **ELINOR BROWN** all my worldly goods and whatsoever I may die possessed of in trust for sole use and benefit of my four children viz. **JOHN, NATHANIEL, DAVID** and **ELINOR** to be disposed of in such manner as my said loving wife shall think proper after my funeral expenses and all my just debts are discharged the residue of which I say my said wife **ELINOR** shall make use of for the benefit of my children aforesaid and I also constitute and appoint her my said loving wife **ELINOR BROWN** my whole and sole Executrix hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me made and appoint this my only last will and testament.
