

This is the last Will and Testament of me, **NATHANIEL BROWN**, of the Parish of Saint James within the Liberty of Westminster in the County of Middlesex, Pawnbroker, made this ninth day of June in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Nine. I leave the place of my Burial to the discretion of my dear wife but do desire that my funeral may be as private as decency will permit and as to my Temporal Estate I dispose thereof as follows. That is to say I gave and bequeath to **JOHN DILLMAN ENGLEHEART** late of the Parish of Saint George Hanover Square in the said County of Middlesex but now of Kew in the County of Surrey, plaisterer and **GEORGE ENGLEHEART** of the same Parish, Miniatures Painter the sum of eight hundred pounds of lawful money of Great Britain in trust to place out the same in their joint names upon Real Security or Parliamentary Funds or public Stocks at interest and from time to time to call in such Money to be lent out on Securities or to sell the said Parliamentary Funds or public Stocks and place and lend out the Money so to be called in or to arise by such salt again upon those life Securities at Interest and my Will is that my said Trustees and the Survivor of them and the Executors or Administrators of such Survivor shall stand and be that possessed of and interested in the said Trust Money funds or Securities upon Trust to pay and apply the Interest or Dividends and yearly produce thereof in and towards the maintenance and education of my Daughter **URSULA SARAH BROWN** in the meantime and until she shall attain the age of twenty one years or be married which shall first happen and that the same be paid to her Mother for that purpose if she shall so long live and when and so soon as my said daughter **URSULA SARAH BROWN** shall attain that age or be married. Then in trust to pay assign and transfer the said sum of Eight hundred pounds or the Funds or Securities in which the same shall be then invested unto my said daughter **SARAH BROWN** her Executors Administrators and assigned to and for her and their own absolute use and benefit and in case my said Daughter **URSULA SARAH BROWN** shall happen to depart this life before she shall attain the age of twenty one years or be married then I will and direct that five eighth parts of the said sum of Eight Hundred Pounds or the funds or Securities in which the sum shall be then invested shall be paid assigned and transferred to my said wife her Executors Admons and assigns to and for her and their own absolute use and benefit and the other three eighth parts to my Daughter in Law **JANE ENGLEHEART** the wife of the said **JOHN DILLMAN ENGLEHEART** her Executors Administrators and assigns to and for her and their own use and benefit. Also I give and bequeath unto the said **JOHN DILLMAN ENGLEHEART** and **GEORGE ENGLEHART** the sum of twenty Guineas each for mourning And as to all the rest and residue of my Estate and Effects of what nature or kind soever I give devise and bequeath the said and all my Right and Interest therein unto my said wife **ELIZABETH BROWN** and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife sole Executrix of this my Will and do likewise commit to her the care and Guardianship of my said daughter **URSULA SARAH BROWN** until she shall attain the age of twenty one years in case my said wife shall so long live but if my said wife shall happen to depart this Life in the minority of my said daughter **URSULA SARAH BROWN** then I nominate the tuition and

*Guardianship of my said daughter unto the said **JOHN DILLMAN ENGLEHEART** and **GEORGE ENGLEHEART** and the Survivor of them his Executors or Administrators and I hereby revoke and declare void all former and other wills or Testamentary Dispositions by me at any time heretofore made and declare this only to be my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I the said **NATHANIEL BROWN** the Testator have hereunto set my hand and Seal this day and year above written **NATH. BROWN** (his signature) Signed, sealed, published and declared by the said **NATHANIEL BROWN** the Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in his presence and in the presence of each other have herewith to subscribe our names as Witnesses attesting the due Execution thereof **THOMAS GOOSTREY ~ TAL. HOWEL** Marylebone Street.*

***This will** was proved at London the Sixth day of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty One before the Worshipful Andrew Coltree Ducarel Doctor of Laws Surrogate of the Right Worshipful Peter Calvert Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the Prerogative of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oath of **ELIZABETH BROWN** widow the relict of the deceased and sole Executrix named in the said Will to whom Admon was granted of all and singular the Goods chattels and credits of the said deceased having been first sworn duly to administration.*
