

***In the name of God Amen*** I **Elizabeth Harrison** widow being of sound mind memory and understanding do make this my last Will and Testament Imprimis I direct that all my just debts be paid and funeral expenses be defrayed by my executrix as soon as possible after my decease Item I give and bequeath to my eldest son **Arthur Harrison** the sum of one shilling to my son **John Harrison** the sum of one shilling to my daughter **Elizabeth** the sum of one shilling and my will further is and I do hereby give and bequeath to reward for long and dutiful attention to me to my youngest daughter **Sarah Harrison** all the rest and residue of my personal estate consisting of household goods, shop goods, book and other debts and all other descriptions of property of which I shall be possessed at the time of my decease and of this my last Will I do hereby appoint my said daughter **Sarah** executrix In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Twenty third day of June in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty two. **Elizabeth Harrison** X (her mark). Signed sealed and published by the testator as her last Will in our presence who have subscribed our names as witnesses thereto in the testators' presence and at her request. The words and funeral expenses be defrayed being first interlined **James Ward ~George Jones**

***This Will*** was proved at London the thirtieth day of April in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eight four before the worshipful **George Harris** Doctor of Laws surrogate of the Right Worshipful **Peter Calvert** also doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the prerogative court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oath of **Sarah Harrison** spinster the daughter of the daughter of the deceased and sole executrix named in the said Will to whom administration was granted of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased she having been first sworn duly to administer.
