in the Quous Lottery for five hundred thousand pounds  
lastly bought by me and my good friend John Woots of

prises benefitt profit and advantage which by reason thereof may  
or shall accrue to me or my Exoriter hereinafter named, Item I give  
and bequeath to my Brother in Law Samuell Malton of the  
parish of Saint Dunstons without Bishopsgate London Weaver the  
summe of Ten pounds of like monney as aforesaid for Mourning  
Item I give and bequeath to the said John Woods the summe  
of five pounds of like monney as aforesaid. Item I give and  
bequeath to my good friend William Dawson of Gunn Street  
in the Old Artillery Ground in the County of Middlesex Weaver  
the like summe of five pounds of like monney as aforesaid Item  
it is my Will and Desire and I do hereby Direct and appoint  
that the house wherem I now live and all the Household Goods  
and Furniture Plate Linen Bedding Pewter Brass and other  
Inplements of household which I shall have therein at the  
time of my Death during so long time as my Exoriter  
herein after named shall think fit but no longer shall be  
made use of for the habitation and Accomodation of such  
of my Children as shall think fit to live therein and that  
the Trade or Employment of a Gallender shall during  
that time be therein exercised and Carried on by my said  
Exoriter for the equal benefitt and Advantage of all my said  
Children and that my Gallender and all my Tools and  
Inplements belonging thereto which I shall leave at the  
time of my Death shall during the continuance of the said  
Trade or Employment be made use of in and about the said  
Trade or Employment and that the Rent of the said house and  
such Rates Taxes and Impositions as shall be assessed or imposed  
thereon or on my said Exoriter in respect thereof or of the  
said Trade or Employment Goods Tools and Inplements  
and all such Charges and Expenses as my said Exoriter  
shall be at in and about repairing the said house and  
Gallender and the amending and making good the said house  
and household Goods Tools and Inplements shall be borne and paid

the rest and residue of my personall Estate not herein before

respective Ages of one and Twenty yeares or on the day  
of their respective Marriages which respectively shall first  
happen. Item it is my Will and Desire and I do hereby Direct

and appoint that my said Executor shall Dispose of the Summe of  
 Twenty pounds or such other Summe as my said Executor shall  
 thinke fit not exceeding the Summe of Twenty pounds part of  
 my son Richards share of my said Estate for the putting of him  
 forth Apprentis and further it is my Will and Desire and I doo  
 hereby also Direct and appoint That my said Executor shall  
 Dispose of the like Summe of Twenty pounds or such other Summe  
 as my said Executor shall thinke fit not exceeding the Summe  
 of Twenty pounds part of my said sons William share of my  
 said Estate for putting him forth Apprentis. And further it is my  
 Will and Desire and I doo hereby Direct and appoint that  
 my said Children respectively shall be maintained and  
 Educated by my said Executor out of their respective shares  
 of my said Estate and the produce and proceeds thereof or of  
 the said Trade or Employment at the Discretion of my said  
 Executor herein after named as follows (Viz) The said John  
 my eldest son untill he shall attaine his age of One and  
 Twenty years; and the said Richard and William my younger  
 sons respectively untill they respectively are Apprentis  
 and afterwards with such necessary as shall not be sufficiently  
 provided for them respectively by such Master or Masters  
 as they respectively shall happen to have untill their respective  
 attainments of their respective ages of One and Twenty years  
 and my Daughters at the like Discretion of my said Executor  
 herein after named untill their respective ages of One and  
 Twenty years or Day of their respective Mariages  
 which shall first happen. Item it is my Will and Desire  
 and I doo hereby Direct and appoint That immediately  
 after the Discontinuance of the said Trade or Employment  
 each of my said Children which have received or shall be  
 Intituled to receive his or her share of my said other Estate  
 or any part thereof shall also have and receive a part or  
 share of the Value of the said Household Goods and  
 Furniture Plate Linen Bedding Pewter Brass and other  
 Implements of Household and the said Gallon and the  
 Tools and Implements then belonging thereto and of the  
 produce and proceeds of the said Trade or Employment  
 which shall not be then accounted for and paid unto them  
 respectively in proportion to such share or shares as he she  
 or they shall have then received or shall be then Intituled  
 to receive out of my said other Estate and that the
