

Letter from J. J. SCHEEPERS, Dales Ford, Mepence?, Conquered Territory, Orange Free State to Edward TUNBRIDGE Esq. Addo ? Sundays River, Uitenhage

My dear Sir,

I have just recd a Letter from my Brother **C. F. SCHEEPERS** of Alexandria in which he informed me that you had met another Brother of mine in Grahams Town whom you informed that inquiry had been made for the heir of the late Mr. **James GOOSTRY** who died some time ago in the Grahams Town Hospital.
